Good governance is vital for the success of the IGA, and the Directors' role is pivotal for that. We require a balance of skills, knowledge, experience, and perspective. Having a diverse Board that reflects our membership from around the world, including gender diversity, is paramount.

The IGA is in transition to a new membership model that will be implemented by the new Board in the 2023-2026 term, including

registration in the Netherlands. We require an IGA board member to be:

- Pro-active, value-driven, well-prepared and informed, ready to actively engage!
- Committed to helping shape the strategic goals of the IGA, whilst supporting the Executive Director to execute that strategy


The alliance also aims to position renewable energy as a pillar of sustainable development and economic growth, particularly in the global south.
